Specifications and bid documents are on file in the office of the Township Administration and may be examined or obtained during the normal office hours at the above address on or after **January 17, 2017 upon a non-refundable deposit of \$ 30.00 per set**. Check shall be made payable to West Windsor Township. Bids must be submitted on the prescribed form in a sealed envelope marked:

"Bid Proposal -- West Windsor Township 2017 Public Land Maintenance  
Turfgrass and Stormwater Detention Basin Maintenance."

The work under this contract includes the furnishing of all labor, materials and equipment necessary or required to provide turfgrass and stormwater basin maintenance for approximately 60 stormwater basins, open space lots or median islands located throughout West Windsor Township, between March, 2017 and December 31, 2017 (mow, mulch, prune, clean etc.) for Township Open Space Lands.

A bid deposit in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or bid bond made payable to the Township of West Windsor in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the bid, but not to exceed \$20,000.00, must accompany each proposal as a security, which may be forfeited and retained by the Township in lieu of its other legal remedies, if a successful bidder's proposal is accepted by the Township and he shall fail to execute and return to the Township the required contract and/or bonds within ten (10) days after delivery of the prepared contract and/or bond form to him by the Township.

The Township Council reserves the right to reject any or all proposals in whole or in part and waive such informalities as may be permitted by law.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of P.L. 1975, C. 127 and N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27.
