Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals addressed to the Business Administrator will be received on or before **Thursday, October 8, 2015**, at 11:00am, prevailing time, at which time they will be opened and read at the West Windsor Township Municipal Building, 271 Clarksville Road, Princeton Junction, New Jersey for the work described below.

Specifications, plans and bid documents will be available on or after **September 17, 2015**, and may be examined from the Administration Department located in the West Windsor Township Municipal Building during regular business hours, 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday excluding holidays or obtained upon a non-refundable deposit of \$50.00 per set. Check shall be made payable to West Windsor Township.

The work under this contract includes the furnishing of all labor, material and equipment necessary or required to complete all work set forth in the contract documents.

The Base Bid includes milling and paving 2” thick HMA surface course, removing and reconstructing concrete curb, sidewalk, and handicap ramps, rehabilitation of inlets and installation of compliant inlet headers and grates, striping, signage and pavement markings, other incidental work and traffic control as necessary to complete the work.

Approximate quantities include but are not limited to milling of 24,650 SY of the existing surface course, placement of 3,200 tons of Superpave Hot Mix Asphalt Surface Course and Leveling Course 9.5M64, curb replacement of 3,240 LF, 4” concrete walk replacement of 10,660 SF with 34 detectable warning surfaces, 15,670 LF of epoxy striping, 1,690 LF of 24” wide thermoplastic striping, installation of 14 new signs, as well as inlet repairs and improvements and other incidental work.

A bid deposit in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or bid bond made payable to the Township of West Windsor in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the bid, but not to exceed \$20,000.00, must accompany each proposal as a security, which may be forfeited and retained by the Township in lieu of its other legal remedies, if a successful bidder's proposal is accepted by the Township and he shall fail to execute and return to the Township the required contract and/or bonds within ten (10) days after delivery of the prepared contract and/or bond form to him by the Township.

The Township Council reserves the right to reject any or all proposals in whole or in part to waive such informalities as may be permitted by law.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of **P.L. 1975, C. 127 and N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27**.
