Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals addressed to the Business Administrator will be received on or before **March, 18, 2014**, at 11:00am, prevailing time, at which time they will be opened and read at the West Windsor Township Municipal Building, 271 Clarksville Road, Princeton Junction, New Jersey for the work described below.

Specifications, plans and bid documents will be available on or after **February 24, 2014**, at 11:00 am, and may be examined from the Administration Department located in the West Windsor Township Municipal Building during regular business hours, 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday excluding holidays or obtained upon a non-refundable deposit of \$30.00 per set. Check shall be made payable to West Windsor Township.

The work under this contract includes the furnishing of all labor, material and equipment necessary or required to complete all work set forth in the contract documents.

The Base Bid includes construction of asphalt tennis courts; asphalt basketball courts; sand volley ball court; asphalt path; split-rail fence; chain link fence; tubular steel gates; and benches.

Quantities include but are not limited to approximately; 5,500 square yards dense graded aggregate; 3,700 square yards crushed stone; 1400 tons asphalt; 35 square yards concrete walks; 40 linear feet of concrete curb; 416 linear feet ten foot chain link fence; 1,100 linear feet split rail fence; 6,750 square yards of lawn preparation; 8 benches; 250 cubic yards of sand; and various furnishing associated with the improvements.

A bid deposit in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or bid bond made payable to the Township of West Windsor in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the bid, but not to exceed \$20,000.00, must accompany each proposal as a security, which may be forfeited and retained by the Township in lieu of its other legal remedies, if a successful bidder's proposal is accepted by the Township and he shall fail to execute and return to the Township the required contract and/or bonds within ten (10) days after delivery of the prepared contract and/or bond form to him by the Township.

The Township Council reserves the right to reject any or all proposals in whole or in part to waive such informalities as may be permitted by law.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of **P.L. 1975, C. 127 and N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27.**
