Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals addressed to the Business Administrator will be received on or before **Thursday, April 2, 2015**, at 11:00am, prevailing time, at which time they will be opened and read at the West Windsor Township Municipal Building, 271 Clarksville Road, Princeton Junction, New Jersey for the work described below.

Specifications, plans and bid documents will be available on or after **Thursday, February 26, 2015**, at 11:00 am, and may be examined from the Administration Department located in the West Windsor Township Municipal Building during regular business hours, 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday excluding holidays or obtained upon a non-refundable deposit of \$50.00 per set. Check shall be made payable to West Windsor Township.

Bids must be submitted on the prescribed form, in a sealed envelope marked:

The work under this contract includes the furnishing of all labor, material and equipment necessary or required to complete all work set forth in the contract documents.

The Base Bid includes but is not limited to the removal & disposal of an existing 1,135 SY 8" thick concrete apron, excavation of approximately 250 CY of sub grade, installation of approximately 1,135 SY of 6" thick dense graded aggregate, installation of a finished concrete apron consisting of steel reinforced, 10" thick, 4500 PSI concrete and application of a concrete hardener and sealer located at the Princeton Junction Volunteer Fire Station as shown on the construction plans.

The Alternate Bid includes but is not limited to the excavation of approximately 225 CY of sub grade, installation of approximately 670 SY of 6" thick dense graded aggregate, installation of a finished concrete floor consisting of steel reinforced, 6" thick, 4500 PSI concrete and application of a concrete hardener and sealer located at the West Windsor Township Public Works Facility as shown on the construction plans.

A bid deposit in the form of a certified check, cashier's check, or bid bond made payable to the Township of West Windsor in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the bid, but not to exceed \$20,000.00, must accompany each proposal as a security, which may be forfeited and retained by the Township in lieu of its other legal remedies, if a successful bidder's proposal is accepted by the Township and he shall fail to execute and return to the Township the required contract and/or bonds within ten (10) days after delivery of the prepared contract and/or bond form to him by the Township.

The Township Council reserves the right to reject any or all proposals in whole or in part and to waive such informalities as may be permitted by law.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of **P.L. 1975, C. 127 and N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27.**
