Reimbursement Policy for Elected Officials

Resolution to Support the Choice of Non-Partisan Elections in either May or November

President Anklowitz advised that by having the Municipal Election in November versus May, it would save the Township approximately \$40,000. He noted his support for the Bill.

Ms. Geevers inquired about how this change would affect the terms of the incumbents.

Mr. Morgan explained that the election to fill the vacancies would be held at the General Election but the incumbents would not be sworn in and take their seats until the Reorganization Meeting the following year on July 1<sup>st</sup>.

Resolution Supporting a Left Turn Lane on Route 571

This resolution was moved to the Business Session held earlier. Chief Pica advised that he was not in favor of removing the "No Left Turn" sign because it is a safety issue. Ms. Ward had acknowledged that it is a County-owned road and the County has been made aware of the issues.

The resolution 2008-R142 was approved at the Business Session.

Resolution Opposing Abolishment of the NJ Department of Agriculture

This resolution was tabled because there has not been any movement by the State to continue this action.

Resolution Opposing S-1137 - Expands the Scope of Negotiations
