DEPARTMENT OF LAW

Mr. Herbert noted that there was not an increase in fees for 2008 for his services or for the services of his firm. He advised the line item cost for litigation also remained the same and noted that Akselrad and Brookline are the two outstanding litigation items for 2008.

Mr. Herbert advised that the Prosecutor and the Public Defender both have an increase in salaries of 3.75% for 2008 per contractual agreements. He also explained that the Public Defender also receives health benefits worth approximately \$20,000 per year whereas the Prosecutor does not receive any benefits.

President Anklowitz inquired about shared services for both the Prosecutor and the Public Defender positions.

Mr. Herbert noted that he was not aware of any shared services being used for these positions but that shared services have been used for Court Room services such as being done in Robbinsville.
