- 121 cases of measles across the United States
- 85% of the outbreak is centered in California
- 1 case of measles in New Jersey
- West Windsor Township has a high vaccination rate due to New Jersey State statutes
- Immunization audit is conducted by the Township Nurse to ensure compliance
- Outlined symptoms: fever, runny nose, cough, red eyes, rash

PUBLIC COMMENT


Mr. John Church, 11 Princeton Place, encouraged compliance of measles vaccination.
