West Windsor Township Awarded \$250,000 Municipal Aid Grant and \$225,000 Bikeway Grant

West Windsor, N.J. -- West Windsor Mayor Shing-Fu Hsueh announced today that the Township has received a grant in the amount of \$250,000.00 from the New Jersey Department of Transportation's Fiscal Year 2014 Municipal Aid Program. The township sought the grant funds for the Alexander Road Reconstruction project.

The letter from NJDOT Commissioner James Simpson states that each year the program becomes more popular and competitive statewide. This year it received 653 applications totaling more than \$255 million for the \$78.75 million available funds from the Transportation Trust Fund (TTF). The township sought the grant funds for the Alexander Road Reconstruction project.

Additionally, the Christie Administration has announced that 71 applications totaling \$22.6 million for grants under the Bikeway program were received statewide. West Windsor Township is one of only four municipalities to be awarded a Bikeway grant in the amount of \$225,000.00 for the Conover Road Bikeway Project.

Mayor Hsueh stated, "The awarded grants are another example of the ongoing cooperation between the Township and the State for the improvement of our local transportation network and implementation of the Complete Street Policy. We will continue to participate in all available programs to improve and protect West Windsor as well as save taxpayers money."
