West Windsor Township Receives \$43,000 for Vaughn Drive Bus Shelter And \$159,000 Alexander Road Reconstruction, Phase 2 Projects

West Windsor, N.J. -- West Windsor Mayor Shing-Fu Hsueh announced today that the Township has been awarded \$43,000 by the New Jersey Department of Transportation, under the *FY 2015 Transit Village Program*, to relocate an existing Bus Shelter currently located at the intersection of Vaughn Drive and Alexander Road to a new location along Vaughn Drive directly adjacent to the West Windsor Parking Authority parking lot. This will assist in alleviating traffic congestion at the signalized intersection due to conflicts between cars, buses and pedestrians exiting the train station.

The Alexander Road Reconstruction Phase 2 Project has also been awarded \$159,000 under the NJDOT *Municipal Aid Program*. This project will provide for pavement and drainage repairs along two westbound lanes of Alexander Road between Vaughn Drive and Roszel Road.

Mayor Hsueh stated, “ The ongoing cooperation between the Township and the State for improvement of our local transportation network continues to enhance safety for the community. We will participate in all available programs to improve and protect West Windsor.”
