### **West Windsor Township Receives \$214,080 Grant**

**West Windsor, N.J.** -- West Windsor Mayor Shing-Fu Hsueh announced today that the Township has been approved to receive a grant in the amount of \$214,080 from the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program-Energy Allocation Initiative. In total \$25 Million is being allocated to 147 out of 750 jurisdictions and public entities to support energy resilience projects. West Windsor Township's request to pursue energy resilience for critical facilities scored among the highest in the State.

Mayor Hsueh stated, "This grant could not have been more timely as we move forward with cost effective and environmentally sound initiatives including the Climate Action Plan, BPU Energy Audit, and Municipal building space needs analysis and future renovation."

In a letter to Mayor Hsueh from Senator Shirley Turner, she stated that the Township could be eligible for substantial additional incentives should there be a decision to pursue a more sophisticated technology. The status of West Windsor Township as a more sustainable community is elevated as a result of being awarded this grant.
