

RESOLUTION  
CALLING ON THE NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION  
TO TAKE ANY AND ALL NECESSARY STEPS  
TO ASSURE THE ALLOCATION OF  
FEDERAL STIMULUS FUNDS FOR INFRASTRUCTURE  
NECESSARY TO SUPPORT REDEVELOPMENT  
AT THE PRINCETON JUNCTION TRAIN STATION


- WHEREAS, the West Windsor Township Council adopted Resolution 2005-R285 designating the 350 acres surrounding the Princeton Junction/West Windsor Train Station as an area in need of redevelopment; and
- WHEREAS, the draft Redevelopment Plan that is nearing completion is an ambitious attempt at addressing the multitude of highly complex issues that must be confronted with respect to the entirety of those 350 acres; and
- WHEREAS, the infrastructure needed to support redevelopment will serve Mercer County, New Jersey State and other regional needs as well as the needs of West Windsor; and
- WHEREAS, the cost of that redevelopment will require infrastructure improvements that should not be a burden on the taxpayers of West Windsor; and
- WHEREAS, the Princeton Junction train station is one of the heaviest-used train stations in the entire United States serving the daily needs of thousands of commuters; and
- WHEREAS, redevelopment of the Princeton Junction train station is important to the success of future mass transportation in the State of New Jersey and should be one of the highest priorities for the allocation of scarce financial resources; and
- WHEREAS, the Congress has enacted a major stimulus package that provides infrastructure financing throughout the United States; and
- WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Transportation will play a major role in the allocation of funds from the Federal stimulus package; and
- WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the residents of West Windsor, Mercer County and the State of New Jersey for that infrastructure to be funded by sources other than the residents of West Windsor.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of West Windsor that the New Jersey Department of Transportation is hereby requested to take any and all necessary steps to assure the allocation of Federal stimulus funds for the infrastructure necessary to support redevelopment at the Princeton Junction Train Station.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this Resolution be sent to Governor Jon Corzine, Commissioner Stephen Dilts, New Jersey Department of Transportation, Congressman Rush Holt, Senator Frank Lautenberg, Senator Robert Menendez, Senator Bill Baroni, Assemblywoman Linda Greenstein and Assemblyman Wayne DeAngelo
