

COVID-19 Vaccinations Update

Third Doses - Moderately to Severely Immunocompromised

West Windsor Health Department is offering appointments for third doses of Pfizer and Moderna vaccine to those who are **moderately to severely immunocompromised**.

Individuals in the following categories qualify for an additional dose of mRNA COVID-19 vaccine:

- Been receiving active cancer treatment for tumors or cancers of the blood
- Received an organ transplant and are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
- Received a stem cell transplant within the last 2 years or are taking medicine to suppress the immune system
- Moderate or severe primary immunodeficiency (such as DiGeorge syndrome, Wiskott-Aldrich syndrome)
- Advanced or untreated HIV infection
- Active treatment with high-dose corticosteroids or other drugs that may suppress your immune response
