GUIDANCE FOR DOMESTIC AND INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL

• WHAT DOES "FULLY VACCINATED" MEAN FOR ME?

- "Fully vaccinated" at least 2 weeks since your final dose of the Pfizer, Moderna, or J&J vaccine.
- Fully vaccinated persons can engage mask-free in private indoor settings.
- Masks are still required in public settings.

DOMESTIC TRAVEL

- Fully vaccinated persons and those recovered from COVID-19 within the last 3 months <u>DO NOT</u> need to get tested nor quarantine.
- Unvaccinated persons should test 1-3 days pre-travel and 3-5 days posttravel.

INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL

- Verify with destination of travel if testing is required upon entry.
- <u>ALL</u> individuals returning to the U.S. **must test (-) within 3 days prior to boarding** and should retest 3-5 days post-travel.
- Unvaccinated persons should stay home and quarantine for 7 days AND test within 3-5 days post-travel (vaccinated persons do not need to quarantine).
- ALL travelers should self-monitor symptoms for 14 days post-travel.
 - If symptoms develop, please self-isolate and get tested.
 - If you test (+) for COVID-19, self-isolate for 10 days and seek medical attention if necessary.
