As you are aware, the Engineering Division has been collecting public comments since the meeting on the proposed Road Diet on April 21, 2015. To date a total of 43 comments have been received in writing. The following table indicates the breakdown of the respondents and their position on the implementation of the Road Diet.

As you can see by the table a total of 31 out of the 43, or 72%, were in favor of implementing the Road Diet. Another 9 out of 43, or 21% clearly opposed, and the remaining 7% are neither clearly supporting nor opposing in their comments.

Several of the comments make specific recommendations towards detailed improvements, which will be taken into consideration at such time as a professional services contract for survey and engineering design is awarded. A few others make reference to bus stops along the corridor, and the Engineering Division will reach out to NJ Transit about possible improvements in that regard. We will also be identifying those comments that we believe require feedback from the Project Traffic Engineer at The Burns Group, before we are able to solicit a contract for professional service for survey and design work.
