

As you are aware, each year the New Jersey Department of Transportation announces that applications will be accepted for the "State Aid Program." This program is comprised of multiple categories for funding including Roadway Infrastructure Projects, Transit Village Bikeway Projects, and Safe Routes to Transit.

Each category is evaluated separately based on numerous criteria. West Windsor has the opportunity to receive funding in more than one category. This year the Engineering Division will submit an application under each category for possible funding as follows:

Category 1 - Roadway Infrastructure Projects

Alexander Road Resurfacing – the proposed resurfacing project will provide for improvements to the easterly half-section (from curbline to centerline) of Alexander Road between Vaughn Drive and Roszel, including milling and overlay, drainage improvements where necessary, curb realignment, improved signage & striping, inlet casting replacements, and concrete sidewalk with handicap ramps & detectable warning surfaces.

Category 2 – Bikeway Projects

<u>Conover Road Bikeway</u> – the proposed improvements consist of constructing a dedicated off road bikeway along Conover Road between South Post Road and Galston Drive. Additional improvements will also consist of improved signage & striping, improved drainage and inlet casting replacements where necessary.

Category 3 – Safe Streets to Transit

<u>Cranbury Road Pedestrian Improvements</u> – the proposed project will construct dedicated bicycle and pedestrian improvements along a section of Cranbury Road (County Route 615) between Princeton-Hightstown Road (County Route 571) and Sunnydale Way. These improvements will provide for roadway expansion for dedicated bicycle and pedestrian pathways including milling and overlay, drainage improvements where necessary, improved signage & striping, inlet casting replacements, concrete sidewalk, and handicap ramps with detectable warning surfaces.

Category 4 - Transit Village

<u>Princeton-Hightstown Road Sidewalk Extensions</u> – the proposed project will construct several missing 4' wide concrete sidewalk sections along a portion of Princeton-Hightstown Road (County Route 571), between Alexander Road and Wallace Road. In addition, crosswalk improvements, signage, striping, detectable warning surfaces and pedestrian countdown timers are also proposed.

This project will complete a continuous sidewalk network that promotes a safer means of travel for pedestrians that choose to walk between the Princeton Junction Train Station, the Sherbrooke residential neighborhood, and various commercial businesses and retail complexes along Princeton-Hightstown Road

The deadline for submitting electronic applications is September 20, 2013. The NJDOT requests resolutions endorsing the applications within 30 days of submittal. These resolutions will be presented to Council at the September 30, 2013 regular business meeting. If you have any questions or would like any additional information please let me know.
