MASTER PLAN WORK SESSION

Draft Utility Plan Element of the West Windsor Township Master Plan

The Planning Board members reviewed, discussed, and made changes/additions to the draft version of the Plan.

The Board Members asked that electrical, natural gas, and renewable energy resources (e.g. solar panels) be incorporated into the Plan, as well as solid waste disposal.

Planner Novak will reference the Green Checklist. He also noted that regarding Wastewater Treatment (Section 3.4), the wording will be the same; however, the numbers may change.

Comments were received from the public:

Alison Miller, 41 Windsor Drive, commented on overhead wires. She feels it is aesthetically necessary to place the wires underground.

JOHN CHURCH, 11 Princeton Place (Zoning Board member not speaking on behalf of the Zoning Board), stated the sewer system was installed in 1977. He asked if all the pumping stations could be converted to a gravity system.

The suggested revisions by the planning board members and public comments will be considered for inclusion into the Draft Utility Plan Element of the Master Plan.

Mr. Surtees stated that the Public Hearing of the Circulation Plan Element and the Utility Plan Element will be September 8, 2021 or early October.

The next Regular meeting is scheduled for August 25, 2021.
