CELEBRATING FEBRUARY AS BLACK HISTORY MONTH

WHEREAS, Black History Month is a time to commemorate the historic struggles of African Americans to gain freedom and equality; and to recognize the importance of these struggles to our country's history and ideals; and to celebrate the many achievements African Americans have made to our economic, cultural, spiritual, and political development as a nation; and

WHEREAS, Black History Month grew out of the establishment in 1926 of Negro History Week by Carter G. Woodson and the Association for the Study of African American Life and History; and

The focus will be on the significant contributions of Black Americans to the workforce throughout history, encompassing both the struggles of slavery and the achievements of Black entrepreneurs and organized labor movements in pursuing economic equality and empowerment; and

WHEREAS, the observance of Black History Month calls our attention to the ongoing need to enhance our understanding of black history, to overcome racism, and to build a society that lives up to its democratic ideals; and

WHEREAS, the Township of West Windsor continues to work toward becoming an even more inclusive community in which all citizens-past, present, and future are respected and recognized for their contributions to our community, the County, and the State; and


WHEREAS the Township of West Windsor is proud to honor the history and contributions of African Americans in our community, such as our senior center and schools throughout New Jersey and the Nation.




