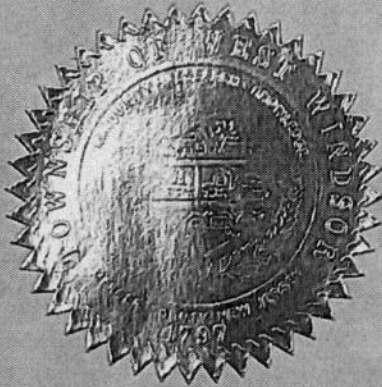


PROCLAMATION


- WHEREAS, West Windsor is proud of its rich cultural history and the many people who call our town home; and




