<u>ACTION REQUESTED</u>: Prior to budget introduction, it is requested that Township Council introduce the attached ordinance authorizing a cost of living adjustment (COLA) of 3.5 percent and the re-establishment of cap banking.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY: 2004 amendments to the cap law eliminated automatic cap banking. For 2023, municipalities are permitted to increase **appropriations** within cap by no more than 2.5 percent, unless action is taken by the governing body to increase the COLA for 2023 to 3.5 percent. The ordinance also permits the banking of any 2023 unappropriated balances for use in future budgets.

This ordinance must be approved by a majority of the full membership of the governing body.

- WHEREAS, the Local Government Cap Law, N.J.S. 40A: 4-45.1 et seq., provides that in the preparation of its annual budget, a municipality shall limit any increase in said budget to 2.5 percent unless authorized by ordinance to increase it to 3.5 percent over the previous year's final appropriations, subject to certain exceptions; and,
- WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A: 4-45.15a provides that a municipality may, when authorized by ordinance, appropriate the difference between the amount of its actual final appropriation and the 3.5 percentage rate as an exception to its final appropriations in either of the next two succeeding years; and,
- WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of West Windsor in the County of Mercer finds it advisable to increase its CY 2023 budget by up to 3.5 percent over the previous year's final appropriations, in the interest of promoting the health, safety and welfare of the citizens; and,

- WHEREAS, there were 694 motor vehicle fatalities in New Jersey in 2022; and
- WHEREAS, approximately 40% of the motor vehicle occupants killed in those traffic crashes were not wearing a seat belt; and
- WHEREAS, use of a seat belt remains the most effective way to avoid death or serious injury in a motor vehicle crash; and
- WHEREAS, the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration estimates that 135,000 lives were saved by safety belt usage nationally between 1975-2000; and
- WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey will participate in the nationwide *Click It or Ticket* seat belt mobilization from May 22 June 4, 2023 in an effort to raise awareness and increase seat belt usage through a combination of high visibility enforcement and public education; and
