Mr. Jacobs introduced himself and the Manager of the Department of Recreation and Parks. He provided a brief overview of his responsibilities such as: administer a full range of youth and adult recreational programs; oversee the finances of the Department through the recreation trust fund; liaison to the Township sport associations; oversee the operation and finances of the community pool; oversee park improvements approved through the capital budget; schedule group park use; and administer special events.

Mr. Jacobs reported for 2023 Township summer camps were held indoors at the schools and were well attended. He noted many Township events were rained out including Community Day however most movie nights were able to be rescheduled and the most well attended movie night was the Bollywood movie "Sholay" which had about 500-600 people in attendance. Mr. Jacobs reported the Township held the Youth Recreational Basketball League and he has received a lot of positive feedback from this program.
