RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST WINDSOR EXPRESSING OPPOSITION TO SENATE BILL S1408 (ASSEMBLY BILL A2757) WHICH PREEMPTS LOCAL ZONING TO ALLOW MIXED-USE DEVELOPMENT TO REPLACE COMMERCIAL OFFICE PARKS AND RETAIL CENTERS

- WHEREAS, municipal zoning authority is a cornerstone of local government, enabling communities to use local experience and information to make decisions that best reflect their needs, priorities, and visions for the future; and
- WHEREAS, West Windsor has established and updated zoning for its community through the legal and public processes of timely Master Plan reexamination and adoption of new and amended Master Plan elements, reflecting its desire for a carefully thought out and well-designed community of residential and commercial properties reflecting economic, environmental and social needs of its diverse people; and
- WHEREAS, West Windsor has been exemplary in its pursuit of affordable housing and has based its development on agreements established under the state laws specifically dedicated to affordable housing; and
- WHEREAS, West Windsor's well planned commercial and retail development provides employment opportunities to many New Jersey residents both inside and outside the township, amenities and commerce for the region, and tax income to support our schools, infrastructure and affordable housing needs; and
- WHEREAS, State law already provides several mechanisms to modify outdated zoning, including Zoning Board variances and zoning changes, which are performed in a public forum, giving consideration to local information, preferences and needs; and
- WHEREAS, Senate Bill S1408 (Assembly Bill A2757) proposes to preempt municipal zoning authority by allowing mixed use development to replace commercial office parks and retail centers regardless of municipal Master Plan and Zoning regulations established under Municipal Land Use Law and which reflect the desires and will of the people; and

- WHEREAS, the proposed legislation provides a low bar for overriding of Township zoning regulations, encouraging predatory business practices against current tenants to force them out, and lack of incentive to fill spaces. The resulting ill situated mixed-use residential developments can destroy a wider commercial district, eliminate jobs, place housing in districts without proper infrastructure and eliminate tax ratables while causing increased school taxes that can force current residents out of their homes; and
- WHEREAS, townships must plan under the Affordable Housing law for an agreed upon number of Affordable units, as well as corresponding market rate units, as part of an affordable housing plan, and the proposed legislation negates this orderly process by requiring towns to take on additional units beyond agreements established under that law. The proposed legislation further degrades the Township's ability to comply with Affordable Housing legislation by providing forced approval of a mixed-use development at only 20% of affordable units, which is less than West Windsor Township's requirement of 25% for other developments.
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the Township Council of the Township of West Windsor, County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, that the Mayor and Council strongly opposes Senate Bill S1408 (Assembly Bill A2757) and urges the New Jersey State Legislature to reject this legislation in order to preserve the important authority of local governments to manage zoning and land use planning in their communities.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Governor of New Jersey, State Senator Shirley Turner, and the members of the New Jersey Senate Community and Urban Affairs Committee, State Assembly members Anthony Verrelli and Verlina Reynolds-Jackson and the members of the New Jersey Assembly Commerce, Economic Development and Agriculture Committee and the New Jersey League of Municipalities.

This request for council action to adopt an updated shared service agreement with Mercer County for the provision of Hazardous Materials response. West Windsor Fire & Emergency Services established a hazardous materials response team in order to mitigate specific hazards within West Windsor Township over 25 years ago. In order to reduce redundancy of service, West Windsor is contracted by Mercer County to provide coverage to a portion of the county. This proposed shared service agreement updates the current system after a prolonged negotiation with the new Mercer County Administration. Those updates include:

- A change in the number of teams and response area
 - Historically there were three HazMat teams in Mercer County provided by Trenton Fire Department, Hamilton Police Department, and West Windsor Fire & Emergency Services. Hamilton Police has subsequently stopped providing HazMat response services resulting in an expansion of coverage areas for both West Windsor and Hamilton.
 - Historically, West Windsor was responsible for West Windsor, Princeton, East Windsor, and Hightstown. We will now add Robbinsville to our area of responsibility.
- Updates to the financial structure
 - Mercer County will take on the responsibility of billing spillers for cost recovery. This project was previously performed by a member of Fire & Emergency Services.
 - Mercer County will provide medical physicals to all members of the West Windsor HazMat team at their expense. At a cost of nearly \$1,000 per physical, and over 20 members assigned to the team, this is major cost savings to West Windsor.
 - Mercer County will provide preventative maintenance to the HazMat response vehicle (SO 45), including oil changes, brake repairs, and other pre-scheduled maintenance.
 - Mercer County will help to provide training to West Windsor HazMat team members at the County's expense.
 - The County will seek grant funding for the replacement of capital equipment for the HazMat teams.
 - Mercer County will provide \$25,000 annually to West Windsor to offset additional costs related to the management of the HazMat team.
 - Mercer County will reimburse West Windsor for any out-of-pocket expenses related to HazMat responses outside of West Windsor where a spiller can not be identified, and therefore can not be billed for cost recovery.

Council Action Taken:					

- WHEREAS, the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq., permits local units of this State to enter into a contract with any other local unit for the joint provision within their combined jurisdictions of any service which any party to the Agreement is empowered to render within its own jurisdiction; and
- WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-5(a) requires that the Shared Services Agreement be approved by resolution of the governing body of each participating municipality and or county; and
- WHEREAS, the County of Mercer, a body politic of the State of New Jersey, with principal offices located at the McDade Administration Building, 640 S. Broad Street, Trenton, NJ 08650 ("County"); and West Windsor Township, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey, with principal offices located at 271 Clarksville Road, West Windsor, NJ 08550 ("Township") are both public bodies corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey and are authorized under New Jersey law to enter a Shared Services Agreement pursuant to the Act; and
- WHEREAS, under N.J.S.A. 26:3A2-21 et seq., Mercer County is mandated to implement a County Environmental Health Act (CEHA) program through its Department of Public Health & Safety: Public Health, addressing air, water, noise, solid waste, Community & Worker's Right to Know, Pesticides, Anti-Idling law and hazardous materials, solid and hazardous waste, emergency response; and
- WHEREAS, the Mercer County Public Health & Safety: Public Health Officer pursuant to N.J.S.A. 26:3-A2-1 et seq. and N.J.S.A. 26:3A2-21 et seq., is designated as the Chief Administrative, Enforcement, and Fiscal Officer for Mercer County's CEHA Program, necessitating a skilled workforce to execute environmental health programs as per relevant laws, regulations, and the Mercer County Public Health & Safety: Public Health, Certified CEHA Work Program; and
- WHEREAS, the Mercer County Department of Public Health & Safety is designated as the responsible party for administrative oversight of all Mercer County Hazardous Material ("HAZMAT") Teams; and
- WHEREAS, West Windsor Township possesses trained personnel capable of executing a Hazardous Material Emergency Response Program in accordance with the Mercer County Public Health Office's Certified CEHA Work Program and the terms of the Shared Services Agreement; and
- WHEREAS, the parties are committed to a collaborative effort in providing HAZMAT Emergency Response; and

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WHEREAS, Mercer County and The Township of West Windsor wish to enter into a Shared Services Agreement for Hazardous Materials Emergency Response as required by the State of New Jersey County Environmental Health Act (CEHA), and

WHEREAS, the term of the Shared Services Agreement is from January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2026, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of West Windsor that the Mayor and Township Clerk are hereby authorized to execute the Shared Services Agreement with Mercer County for Environmental Health and Hazardous Materials Response.
