

Scott Dzierzynski
Master Sergeant, USAF National Guard 1983-2017



Scott Dzierzynski was born in Jersey City, New Jersey on September 15, 1962 to Alfred and Theresa (Rendenna) Dzierzynski. He attended Hudson Catholic High School class of 1980 and studied at Saint Peter's College. Scott enlisted in the USAF Air National Guard in 1983 and served until 2017 at McGuire Air Force Base, Burlington County, New Jersey. He furthered his education completing the NCO Academy at McGuire AFB, NJ in 1996 and

numerous technical training courses. Scott also worked as a Crew Chief Supervisor at McGuire Air Force Base for thirty-four years. Scott married Maureen Brandon in 1987 and was married for 32 years. He loved his wife and every morning when she said "hope you have a good day," he would respond "every day married to you is a good day."

Scott was a retired Master Sergeant of the USAF National Guard and proudly served during Desert Storm (1990-1991) and Operation Enduring Freedom (2001). During Scott's military career he was awarded many awards



and served to help with Operation Restore Hope, the military effort to ensure that famine relief supplies got to the Somalis' who desperately needed them. He was recognized, along with other military families, by Gov. Jim Florio and his wife Lucinda at a reception hosted for the military families who helped in this effort at Drumthwacket the Governor's mansion in Princeton December of 1992. Scott additionally served to assist during Rwandan genocide in 1994. He also served in Operation Crisis Reach 1996 and support of Tanker Air Bridge while serving at Lajes Field, Azores, Portugal in 2003.



Scott received many awards and decorations over 34 years namely: Air Force Commendation Medal, Air Force Achievement Medal, Air Force Outstanding Unit Award with Valor Device, Air Reserve Forces Meritorious Service Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Southwest Asia Service Medal, Global War On Terrorism Service Medal, Armed Forces Service Medal, Air Force Expeditionary Service Ribbon with Gold Border, Air Force Longevity Service, Armed Forces Reserve Medal, USAF NCO PME Graduate Ribbon, Air Force Training Ribbon, and Kuwait Liberation Medal Government of Kuwait.
