### MERCER COUNTY /TRENTON HEALTH TEAM TESTING SITE

**Must be 18 years of age or older.**

This site is open weekdays from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. To receive an appointment, your doctor must send notification to the site. The testing center is by appointment only for Mercer County residents age 18 or older who have a prescription from their primary health care provider (PCP). If you are symptomatic for COVID-19 or asymptomatic, and want to be tested, contact your PCP. **Physicians:** Fax prescription with patient's home address to 609-630-4031.

Register for an appointment online at <https://www.riteaid.com/>. You will be required to use or create a Google Account during the registration process. **Persons without an appointment will not be tested.** All Rite Aid COVID-19 testing locations utilize self-swab nasal tests overseen by Rite Aid pharmacists. At all testing locations, patients are required to provide government issued identification and be at least 18 years old. There is no cost and a doctor's prescription is not needed. During your drive-up appointment, you will be given a self-swab nasal test that you will administer to yourself in the privacy of your vehicle.
