- 1. Complete the application and essay.

Regional Or Private High School Students: PLEASE NOTE THAT THE APPLICATION AND ESSAY <u>MUST</u> BE RETURNED TO <u>YOUR HOMETOWN</u> MAYOR, <u>NOT</u> THE MAYOR OF THE MUNICIPALITY WHERE YOUR HIGH SCHOOL IS LOCATED (UNLESS THAT IS YOUR HOMETOWN).

- 3. The mayor or a designated committee will select one semi-finalist from your municipality.
- 4. All entrants will receive a certificate of participation from the Mayor's office.
- 5. The winner from each municipality will be designated as a state semi-finalist. They will have their essay and application reviewed by the Scholarship Committee of the New Jersey State League of Municipalities.
- 6. All state semi-finalists will receive a certificate attesting to their status as state semi-finalists.
- 7. The Scholarship Committee will select 15 finalists and 3 winners.
- 8. The 15 finalists will each be awarded finalist certificates. The three winners will each be awarded \$1,000.00 by their mayor at a hometown ceremony.
- 9. Winners' essays will be featured in the New Jersey Municipalities magazine.
